

Government Resolution No. :- USG-1493/2428-VS-4

Ministry of state, Extension House, Mumbai – 400-032

Dated 22 Jun, 1995

Read :- 1. Government Resolution, Higher & Technical and Employment Planning Dept. No. USG-1493/2428/Vs/-4 Dated 23rd June, 1994 and same numbered corrigendum Dated- July, 1994.

2. Government Resolution, Social welfare, cultural and sport Dept. No. CDC- 1494/ P.N. 338/BCC-5 Dated 13 June, 1995 and same numbered corrigendum dated 15th June 1995.

3. Government Resolution Generals Administration Department No. VCC-1094/P.G.68/94/16 dated 15th June 1995.

Government Resolution: -1. Excluding the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes in the state some other castes and tribes demanded special concession on the basis of socially financial and educationally backward grounds. Considering their demands an order related to inclusion of specific castes in special backward class has been issued in the Government Resolution, Social Welfare, Cultural & Sports Dept. No. CVC-1494/P.No.236 BCC-5 dated 13th June, 1995 & same numbered corrigendum dated 15th June 1995. The list of the castes included in special backward classes has been given in Annexure 'A' enclosed.

2. As per Government Resolution, General Administration Section No. VCC-1094/P.No.-68/94/16-W dated 15th June 1995 2% reservation be provided to 'Special Backward Class' for the purpose of appointment in Government /Semi Government Services such order have been issued in the aforesaid G.R.

3. As per the order issued in Government Resolution Higher & Technical Education and Employment Planning Dept. No. US6-1493/C2428)-WS-4/dated 23rd June 1994 and same numbered corrigendum dated – July 1994 50 % seats be reserved for the students belonging to other backward classes for the purpose of admission to non-agriculture universities and affiliated government /non-government and Arts , Science and Commerce, Education and other educational institution. As some special castes have been included in 'Special Backward Class', 2 % seats have been reserved for such classes in all the education institution run under the governance of Higher & Technical Education Department. On account of issuance of such order pertaining to increase of 2 % reservation provided to 'Special Backward Class' the proportion of reserved seats in educational institution shall be as under.

1. The persons, accepted Buddha Religion, from schedule caste and schedule tribes – 13 %

2. Schedule Tribes – 07 %
3. Vimukta Jati (14 Similar Jati) – 03 %
4. Nomadic Tribes (Prior to January 1990 and Similar castes) – 2.5 %
5. Nomadic Tribes (Dhangar and similar Jamati) – 3.5 %
6. Nomadic Tribes (Wanjari and Similar Jamati) – 2 %
7. Other Backward Class (OBC) - 19 %
8. Special Backward Class – 2 %

52 %

These orders have come in to effect from the session 1995-96.

4. The concerned reservation shall be provided program wise in every institution and it will be proportionate to free and paid seats respectively.

The reserved seats be filled in with priority. But even after seeking admission through reserved seat the application of the candidate is considered to the course or institution on the basis of merit or to avail of the upper choices available through unreserved seats his application be considered on his request.

5. While admitting a candidate if a reserved seat for any class remained vacant on account of non-availability of a suitable candidate, such a seat is filled in by selecting candidate from the other groups included in backward classes. For this purpose refer to para 2nd of the government resolution dated 27th June 1994 and do the needful action in accordance with the guidelines provided in the aforesaid G.R. But while filling in such posts by reshuffling the candidates from other classes the basis figure of 52 % of total reservation should the not be exceeded.

6. As the academic session 1995-96 has already commenced the students, belong to Special Backward Class, willing to seek admission should submit Annexure 'B' up to 31st July 1995 as provided in the Government Resolution No.CVC-1494/p.n.236/BCC-5, dated 13th June 1995 issued by the Social Welfare, Cultural and Sports Department. It is mandatory on the part of such students to submit the particulars related to their castes vide Annexure 'B' to the concerned management. If they fail to submit it within the mentioned date to the head of the institution, they should take note that they shall lose their claim on the reserved seats.

7. It is requested that the Director, Higher Education Pune, should bring these orders to the notice of the Management of all the education institutions.
